Read Judges 6:11-14
Each person share about one of the following questions

- What did you like about this passage?

- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

In Judges 6:12 God calls Gideon "Mighty Warrior"

- Discuss why this might have been hard for Gideon to hear.
- Discuss the idea that God was giving Gideon a new identity.

In Judges 6:14 God tells Gideon to "go in the strength you have."

• Discuss this "new calling" of Gideon and the faith steps that Gideon had to take to follow God in this.


Aaron shared many of the "new identities and callings" God has for his children.
