*In Judges 6:12 God calls Gideon "Mighty Warrior"*

- ☐ Discuss the idea that God was giving Gideon a new identity.

*In Judges 6:14 God tells Gideon to "go in the strength you have."*

- ☐ Discuss this "new calling" of Gideon and the faith steps that Gideon had to take to follow God in this.

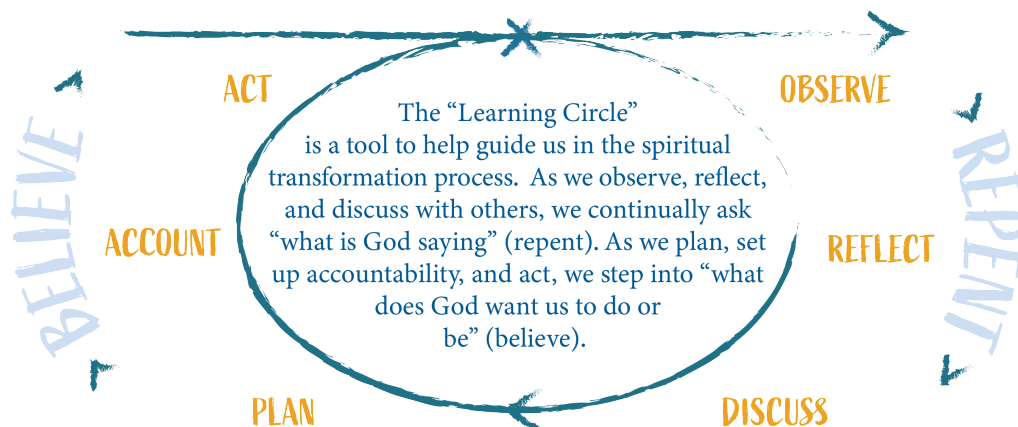
*Aaron shared many of the "new identities and callings" God has for his children.*
