- ☐ Discuss the statement: "God's faithfulness is greater than our failure."

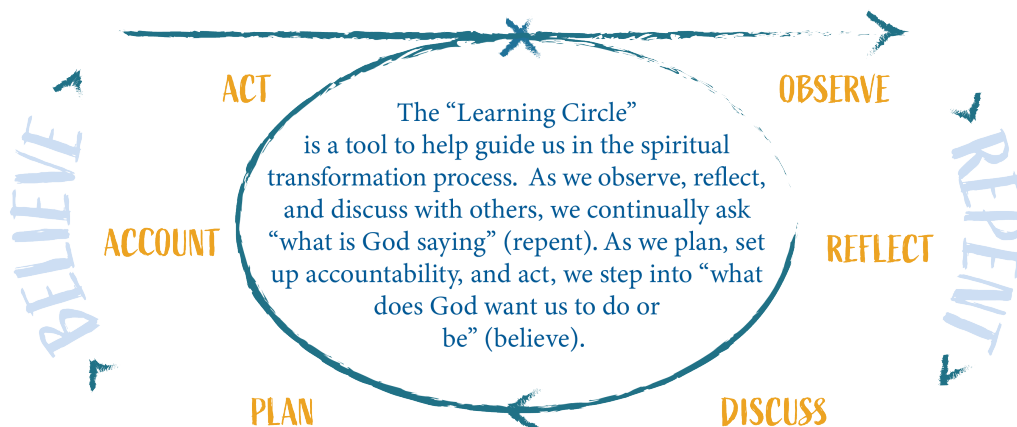
When we fail, we should be ready to act in faith again.

- ☐ How has God given you second chances to honor him?
