Icebreaker: Share a high/low from the past couple of weeks

STUDY GUIDE

Read 2 Kings 22

Each person share about one of the following questions:

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

Aaron talked about 2 different aspects of holiness within the believer: Imputed Holiness (given to us by God at salvation) and Practical Holiness (the continual process of becoming more like Christ in our actions and living)

- Discuss the difference between these two aspects of holiness
- Which one do you resonate with? Which one is harder to understand?

Read 1 Peter 1:15-16

- Discuss "be holy in all your conduct". Is this imputed or practical holiness?
- Discuss the Word "Be Holy because I am Holy.
- How does the "because" speak to both the why, and the how of being holy?
- Discuss different aspects of the "because" and how that relates to your process of Christ-likeness.


Read 2 Kings 2:11-13a

- Discuss the relevance of Josiah humbling himself before he even heard what God wanted him to do (before he consulted the prophetess).
- Where do you see revival in this story? Is there a "spark" (beginning) of revival?

What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?

- Why did it get your attention? (What made you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?

Before you leave, go around and name someone in your life who needs Christ. Spend some time praying for them and for one another.
