- Discuss this reading: Is there anything you discovered about prayer?
- Discuss the phrase "shameless audacity." What implications for prayer does this have for you?

- Do you agree or disagree with this statement?
- When people pray, there often isn't "shameless audacity". Describe your prayer life. Where might the Spirit be asking you for more shamelessly audacious prayers?

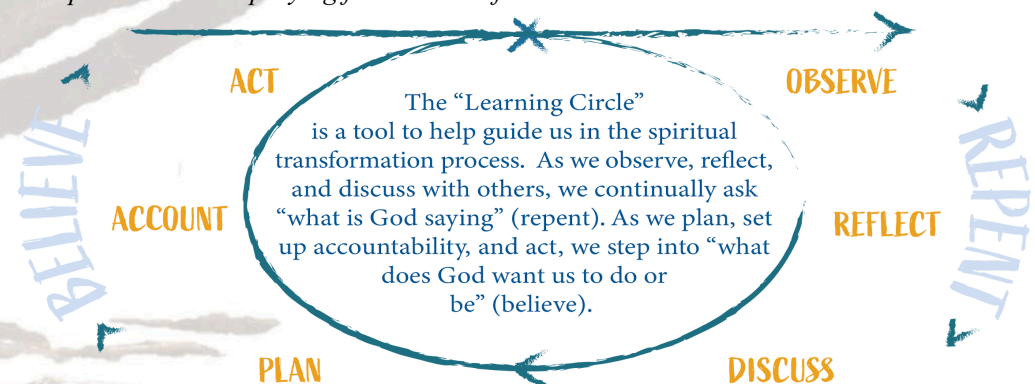
Take some time to pray with and for one another.

- Stay put in your prayers – don't rush through them but sit in God's presence.
- Spill your heart – don't just say words, let your prayers be filled with your heart.
