Read Acts 19:17

- Put yourself in Ephesus at that time. What would you be thinking, and how would you have "held in honor" the name of Jesus?
- Has there been a time in your life where you have experienced a clear call to honor the name of Jesus?

One of the great temptations is to "create God" in our own image.

A.W. Tozer said that "What comes into our minds when we think about God is the most important thing about us"

- Do you agree or disagree with Tozer?
- Discuss ways our culture creates God in our own image.
- What are ways you may be doing this?

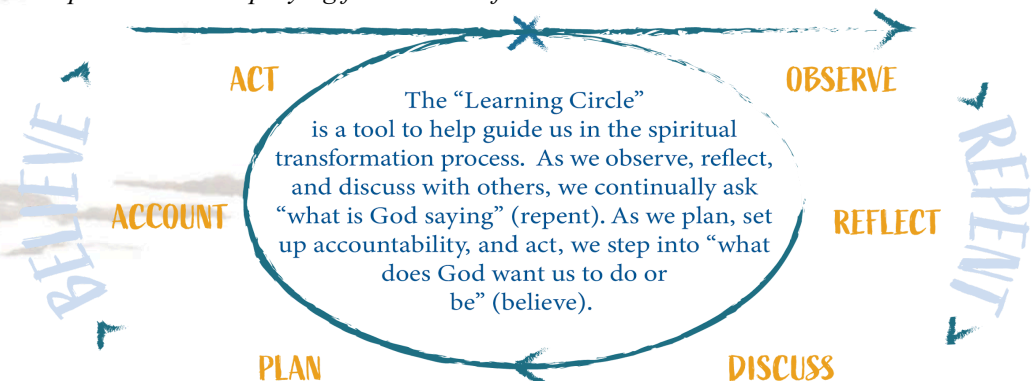
Aaron said: "We can't talk about honoring Jesus without first addressing our innate desire to honor self."

- Are there areas that you struggle putting Jesus before self?
- Read Acts 19:20 and discuss how revival is tied into honoring Jesus.
