## STUDY GUIDE

*Read Luke 1:26-56*

*Each person share about one of the following questions:*

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

*Mary was confronted with some incredible news about becoming a mom.*

- For those who are parents – think back to the moment you found out you were going to be a mom or dad. What kind of emotions were you experiencing?
- For those who are not parents – think about a time when you were told some incredible news – What might Mary have been feeling?

*Re-read Luke 1:26-38*

- Discuss what the angel meant by telling Mary she was highly favored.
- The word here is from the root word for “grace” which is not about earned merit, but God’s divine kindness: How does this impact your understanding of the Angel announcement?

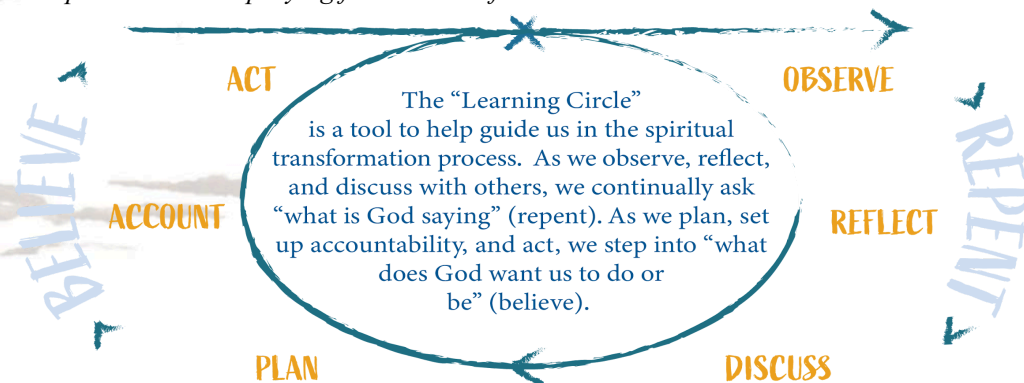
*Mary responds with the words: “I am the Lord’s servant,” Mary answered. “May your word to me be fulfilled.”*

- Discuss Mary’s humility in surrendering to God’s version of her future.
- Discuss what it means that Mary uses the word “slave”? (The word is “doulos” which is a great study to see how other believers accepted “Doulos” as a relational term with God.)

*What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?*

- Why did it get your attention? (What made you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?

*Before you leave, go around and name someone in your life who needs Christ. Spend some time praying for them and for one another.*
