- ☐ How might God use the "insignificant" things you are doing now to prepare you for what's next?

*In 1 Samuel 17:34-37, David demonstrates an understanding for how God had been preparing him.*

- ☐ Do you recognize ways that God has already been equipping you for what He has called you to do?
- ☐ How can you learn to rely on the ways that God has prepared you?


*In 1 Samuel 17:38-40, David rejects man's plans for how to move forward.*
