### STUDY GUIDE

*Read Hosea 10*

*Each person share about one of the following questions:*

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

*Reread the first verse of Hosea 10.*

- Discuss how this chapter could be talking about us today.
- Where has our prosperity fostered a hard heart?

*In Hosea 10:12 God tells Israel to plant seeds of righteousness. This word describes a "long walk of obedience" before the Lord.*

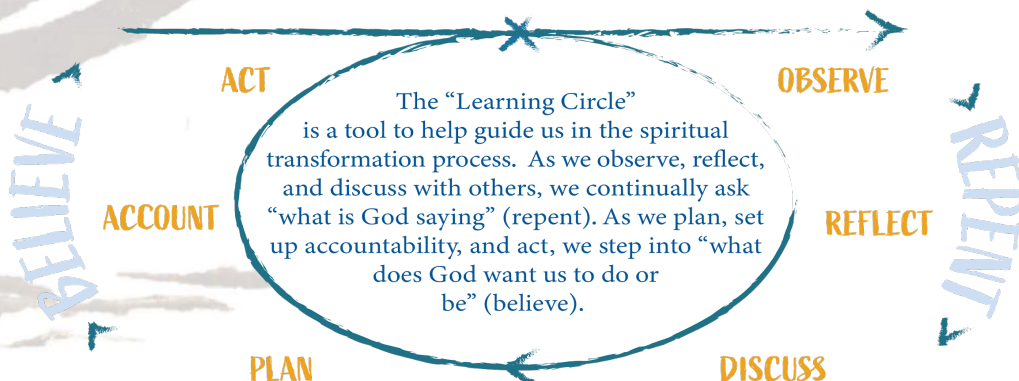
- Where do you see yourself stumbling in this long walk of obedience.
- Read Galatians 5:16-26: Where do you see yourself striving to walk in obedience without walking in the Spirit?

*The "Good News" of revival is the joy and righteousness that comes from God as we follow him. Read the parable in Matthew 13:44.*

- Where do you see "revival" in this story?
- Discuss the idea of the man selling everything he had...with joy
- Where have we replaced the joy of the Lord with anxiety and fear?

*What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?*

- Why did it get your attention? (What made you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?
