STUDY GUIDE

Read Hosea 10

Each person share about one of the following questions:

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

Reread the first verse of Hosea 10.

- Discuss how this chapter could be talking about us today.
- Where has our prosperity fostered a hard heart?

In Hosea 10:12 God tells Israel to plant seeds of righteousness. This word describes a “long walk of obedience” before the Lord.


- Where do you see yourself stumbling in this long walk of obedience.
- Read Galatians 5:16-26: Where do you see yourself striving to walk in obedience without walking in the Spirit?

The “Good News” of revival is the joy and righteousness that comes from God as we follow him. Read the parable in Matthew 13:44.

- Where do you see “revival” in this story?
- Discuss the idea of the man selling everything he had...with joy
- Where have we replaced the joy of the Lord with anxiety and fear?

What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?

- Why did it get your attention? (What made you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?
