STUDY GUIDE

Read Galatians 3:23-29

Each person share about one of the following questions:

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

This week we conclude our "Breaking Ground" series where we have been sharing about the "costs" of preparing for revival.

- Discuss the idea that revival is costly (yet we can't buy it).
- Which of these "costs" do you struggle with most? Why?
Surrendering to the Spirit, Drawing Near to God, Hungering Thirsting for the Lord, Giving up Control, Standing Firm, Identifying with Jesus.

Read Isaiah 53:5, John 20:27, and Rev. 5:6

The message talked about how Jesus was "branded" (marked) in his humanity and that branding will stay with Jesus forever.

- Discuss what this means to you.
- How does Jesus' choice in being "branded" impact your desire to surrender to him."

Galatians 3:27-29 talks about the new identity we have in Christ.

- Why is it hard for us to accept and live in the new identity we have in Christ?
- Why do you think it is hard for us to separate ourselves from our old identity?
- What areas of your life do you struggle living in your new identity?

What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?

- Why did it get your attention? (What made you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?
