## STUDY GUIDE

*Read 1 Peter 1:13-25*

*Each person share about one of the following questions*

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

*Peter commands us to "Be holy" — not just "do holy things."*

- What do you think is the difference between holiness as behavior versus holiness as a way of being?
- Which one do you tend to focus on more in your own life?

*The message suggested that holiness and happiness (joy, peace, flourishing) are deeply connected.*

- Do you agree or struggle with that idea?
- Can you think of a time when obedience to God eventually led to greater joy,

*The sermon asked us to consider that God may use everyday situations—marriage, work, friendships, parenting, hardships—not just to make us happy, but to make us holy.*

- What current situation in your life might God be using to shape your character and make you more like Christ?
- What practical habits or rhythms help you keep your heart focused on Him rather than simply trying harder?

*What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?*

- Why did it get your attention? (Did something made you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?

*Before you leave, go around and name someone in your life who needs Christ. Spend some time praying for them and for one another.*
