Icebreaker: Share a high/low from the past couple of weeks

STUDY GUIDE

Read Acts 2:1-41

Each person share about one of the following questions

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

The message emphasized a shift from the Spirit coming "on" people in the Old Testament to "in" people in the New Testament at Pentecost.

- What difference does this make in how you view your daily life with God?
- The message asked: "Are we living without Pentecost?" How would you honestly answer that right now, and why?
- What are some ways we unintentionally live as if Pentecost never happened?

Acts 2 shows the Spirit immediately moving the church outward in mission.

- Why do you think revival and mission are always connected?
- What is one area of your life where you need the Spirit's power to move you toward people, not just toward personal growth?
- God knows the name of each person...what is the name of someone you know who needs the Gospel. Pray for these names.

What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?

- Why did it get your attention? (Did something made you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?

Before you leave, go around and name someone in your life who needs Christ. Spend some time praying for them and for one another.
