## STUDY GUIDE

*Read Acts 4:1-31*

*Each person share about one of the following questions*

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

*Read Ephesians 1:13-14, Ephesians 5:18. Aaron shared 2 foundations for "being bold" for the Gospel. 1) Being Filled with the Spirit, 2) Praying for boldness.*

- What's the difference between having the Holy Spirit (salvation) and being filled with the Holy Spirit?
- Why does this distinction matter in everyday Christian living?
- Aaron said that it's possible for a person to be a Christian their whole life, but never be filled with the Spirit. Discuss your thoughts to this statement

*The Sunday Summed Up this week is "It's about His power, and not our excuses." Acts 4 shares about bold faith in sharing the Gospel.*

- Share a story of you sharing your faith...how did it feel...what was the outcome?
- When it comes to sharing your faith, what tends to hold you back most—fear, lack of confidence, feeling unprepared, concern about what others will think, or something else?
- Discuss ways you can pray for more boldness this week. Is there someone you can ask to help you accountable for this?

*What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?*

- Why did it get your attention? (Did something made you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?

*Before you leave, go around and name someone in your life who needs Christ. Spend some time praying for them and for one another.*
