*Read Daniel 2*

*Each person share about one of the following questions*

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

*Reread Daniel 2:17-18: Daniel's response was to go to God in prayer.*

- When the "heat is on" in your life, what is your natural first response—trusting God, trying to control outcomes, or retreating in fear.
- Where in your life are you currently treating prayer as a backup plan instead of your primary dependence?

*Daniel invited others into the crisis with him (Hananiah, Mishael, Azariah).*

- Describe a time you asked others to pray with / for you.
- Who are the people you actively bring into your hardest moments for prayer and support, and what keeps you from reaching out more quickly?

*Daniel's prayer was not just for deliverance, but for God's mercy—trusting God's character (His hesed)*

- Describe a time when you said to God "I give up"
- How would your prayers change if your main request was "God, be merciful and reveal who You are," rather than just "God, fix this situation"?

*What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?*

- Why did it get your attention? (Did something made you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?

*Before you leave, go around and name someone in your life who needs Christ. Spend some time praying for them and for one another.*
