## STUDY GUIDE

*Read Daniel 3*

*Each person share about one of the following questions*

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

*Daniel's friends experienced pressure "under fire"*

- When the "heat is on" in your life, what is your natural first response—trusting God, trying to control outcomes, or retreating in fear.
- When hardship comes, do you tend to seek God's deliverance from the fire or God's presence in the fire? Why?

*The message pointed out that it's possible to live your entire Christian life and never truly experience the presence of God*

- Describe a time when you experienced his presence...or when you wished you would have.
- Share Scripture passages describing God with us. Discuss the difference between God's presence as "a fact" (theology) verses "an experience"

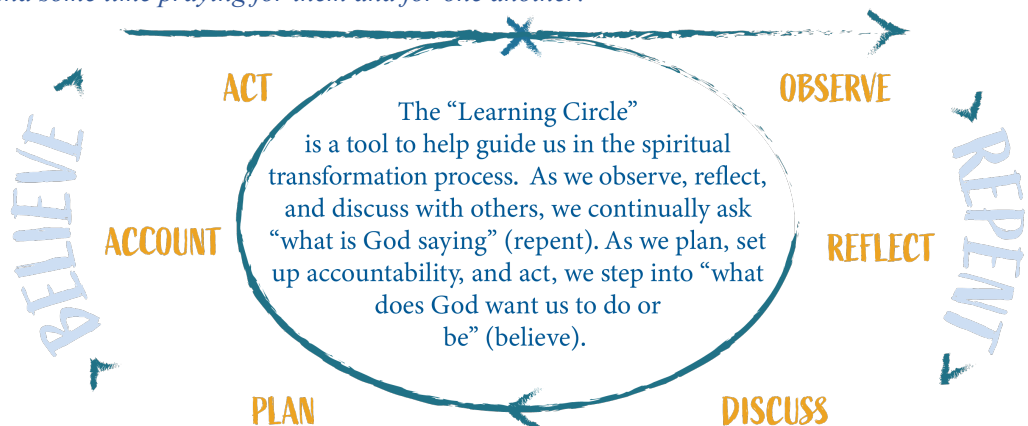
*Read James 4:7-8*

- Discuss the 3-step process in receiving God's promise of coming near to us?
- Where do you need God's "Manifest Presence" today? Which of the steps above might he be asking you to pursue with greater fervency?

*What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?*

- Why did it get your attention? (Did something make you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?

*Before you leave, go around and name someone in your life who needs Christ. Spend some time praying for them and for one another.*
