## STUDY GUIDE

*Read Hebrews 10:19-22*

*Each person share about one of the following questions:*

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

*In James 4:8, God gives us a beautiful promise, followed by some critical instructions.*

- Why do you think God attaches these instructions to this promise?
- What does this promise from God tell us about our relationship with Him?
- Are there things in your life that are preventing you from "drawing near"?

*In Hebrews 10:19-22, we learn about the confidence that we can have to approach God because of what Jesus has done for us!*

- How have you typically interacted with God in the past? Have you seen yourself as a confident child of God or as something else?
- How can this confidence shape our relationship with God?

*We primarily draw near to God through quiet confession, study, and prayer.*

- Is quiet time alone with God part of your rhythm of life? How could it be?

*What got your attention during the message/discussion this week?*

- Why did it get your attention? (What made you mad, sad, glad or go hmm?)
- What might God be saying to you about this?
- What might God be saying to do/be about this?
- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?

*Before you leave, go around and name someone in your life who needs Christ. Spend some time praying for them and for one another.*
