Read Luke 2:41-47

Each person share about one of the following questions:

- What did you like about this passage?
- What didn't you like or made you uncomfortable about this passage?
- What didn't you understand about this passage?
- What does this passage teach us about Jesus?

In Luke 2:48-50, Jesus demonstrates the priority of obedience to God before even rightful earthly authority.

- Why is it so challenging at times for us as believers to put God's authority before our personal priorities and expectations?
- What is one aspect of your life where God may be asking you to obey Him first?

In Luke 2:51, Jesus models obedience to his earthly authorities, even though He Himself was/is God!

- How does God want us, as believers, to interact with our earthly authorities?
- How can we know when it is ok, and even necessary, to disobey earthly authorities?

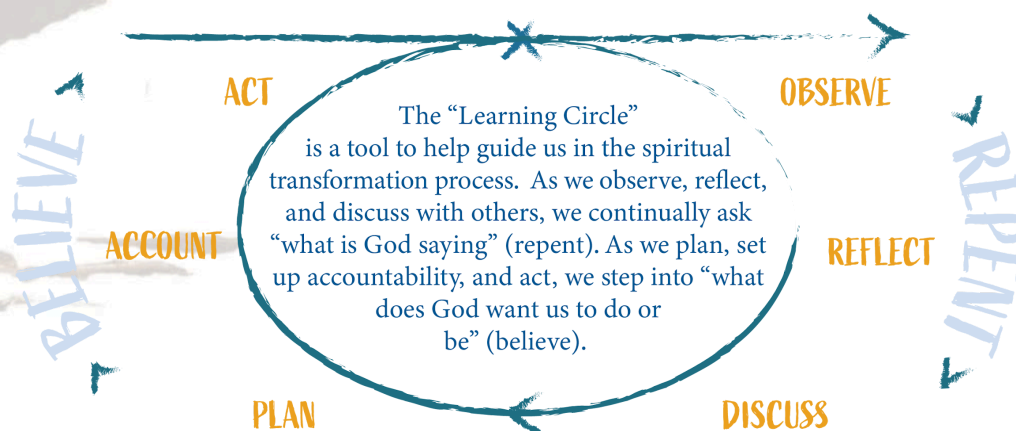
Luke 2:52 and John 17:20-21 both speak to what happens when we live in humble unity with God and others.

- How could God use your humble obedience to change the world around you?

- What ways do you need to step more fully into a true follower of Jesus?
