Matthew 10

10:1-15 – Choosing and commissioning "the Twelve."

These are the twelve "apostles," those who are sent out.

No indication other disciples had their <u>authority & powers</u>.

They were sent to "the lost sheep" of *Israel*.

They freely used these gifts without charge.

10:16-31 – To perform Jesus's work, there is always <u>a cost.</u>

10:16-23 – The cost of discipleship: threats, persecution, and <u>betrayal.</u>

10:24-31 – The courageous response: "Do not fear."

10:32-39 – The comforting reward: Jesus will recognize us and present us to *the Father*.

There is a cost to being found <u>worthy</u> (x3)

10:40-42 – For "taking up the cross," there are <u>rewards</u> (x3)
