

# Matthew 12

12:1-14 – The conflict between Jesus and the Pharisees regarding the laws of the Sabbath.

The complaint of the Pharisees in the grainfields (1-8).

The complaint of the Pharisees in the synagogue (9-14).

12:15-21 – Jesus fulfills Isaiah's prophecy of "the Servant."

12:22-32 – Jesus introduces the unpardonable sin: blasphemy against the Holy Spirit.

12:33-37 – The condemnation of unbelievers based on their words.

12:38-45 – The drastic consequences of demanding “signs”:  
the exposure of one’s skeptical (unbelieving) heart.

12:46-50 – One’s personal relationship with Jesus is validated by  
those who do the will of God.
