Matthew 13

13:1-58 – Matthew presents a collection of Jesus's *parables*.

The purpose of Jesus's parables is to present spiritual truths to those who believe and to hide truth from <u>unbelievers</u>.

All the parables examine the condition of the *heart*.

13:3-23 – The parable of the *sown seed*.

Jesus answers the disciples as to why He teaches by parables: parables expose *the heart* (10-17)

Jesus explains the parable of the sown seed: it's all based on people's response to *His Word* (18-23)

- 13:24-52 Six more parables about the kingdom of heaven.
 - 24-30 (34-43): The kingdom of heaven will always be attacked.
 - 31-32: The kingdom of heaven will always *grow*.
 - 33-43: The kingdom of heaven creates *spiritual growth*.
 - 44: The kingdom of heaven is worth *everything*.
 - 45-46: The kingdom of heaven is of supreme value.
 - 47-52: The kingdom of heaven separates & divides.
- 13:53-58 The consequences of *unbelief*.
