Matthew 14

14:1-12 – The death of *John the Baptist*.

This is Herod Antipas, the son of *Herod the Great*.

Herod the Great, alive when Jesus was born, killed "the innocents."

Herod Antipas would be part of killing <u>Jesus</u>.

(There are two other Herods in Scripture: Acts 12 & Acts 25)

John the Baptist confronted Herod concerning incest (sin).

14:13-21 — Feeding the *five thousand*.

Note: They all ate and were <u>satisfied</u>.

Note: After eating, there were <u>12 baskets full.</u> (This is a symbol of the 12 tribes of Israel.)

14:22-36 – Jesus walks on water and commands Peter to <u>also!</u>
Peter also walks on water until taking his eyes off <u>Jesus!</u>

Jesus admonishes Peter for his lack of *faith*.

The disciples declare Jesus the Son of God.
