Herodian Dynasty

Herod the Great (37-4 B.C.) Known for his massive building projects; massacre of the "Innocents"; ruling at time of Jesus' birth.

Herod Philip (Archelaus) (A.D. 4-6; Matt. 2:22)
(Half-brother to Herod Antipas)

Herod Antipas (4 B.C. to A.D. 39) Responsible for executing John the Baptist; reigning during Jesus' ministry and death; reigning at Pentecost.

Herod Agrippa I (A.D. 4-40) Imprisoned Peter; death by "worms" (Acts 12:20-28)

Herod Agrippa II (A.D. 40-54) Appears in Acts 25; reigning at Paul's trial in Caesarea.
