### Herodian Dynasty

**Herod the Great** (37-4 B.C.) Known for his massive building projects; massacre of the "Innocents"; ruling at time of Jesus' birth.

**Herod Philip** (Archelaus) (A.D. 4-6; Matt. 2:22)  
(Half-brother to Herod Antipas)

**Herod Antipas** (4 B.C. to A.D. 39) Responsible for executing John the Baptist; reigning during Jesus' ministry and death; reigning at Pentecost.

**Herod Agrippa I** (A.D. 4-40) Imprisoned Peter; death by "worms" (Acts 12:20-28)

**Herod Agrippa II** (A.D. 40-54) Appears in Acts 25; reigning at Paul's trial in Caesarea.
