Matthew 15

15:1-9 – Confrontation with Pharisees and Scribes: their traditions are more important than *people*.

The concern of the religious leaders is not about *the Law*.

Jesus is quick to point out their <u>misplaced priorities</u>.

Their concern is more about rules rather than *love*.

Their problem is *their hearts*.

15:10-20 – The true problem with mankind: <u>the heart.</u>

"Heart" refers to a person's inner core and <u>values.</u>

"Heart" is the true measure of a person's <u>inner self.</u>

15:21-28 – Jesus's ministry reaches to the Gentiles.

"Tyre and Sidon" are almost completely *Gentile*.

The issue here is not race: it is *faith*.

15:29-39 – Continued ministry to *the Gentiles*.

The Gentiles also get healed and *fed*.

This represents Jesus's ministry to the rest of the world.
