

Matthew 19

19:1-2 – Jesus begins His journey to Jerusalem, which is ultimately His journey to the cross.

19:3-12 –The hypocrisy of the Pharisees: seeking to justify their unbiblical practice of divorce.

The Pharisees and their abuse of women.

Jesus affirms the scriptural teaching on marriage: one flesh.
In other words, in God's eyes the "two" are "one."

Marriage: a "type" and symbol of the Godhead.

10-12: Jesus compares commitment to that of eunuchs.

19:13-15 – The faith of children should be reflected in the faith of Jesus's followers.

19:16-26 – Jesus's sad encounter with the rich young ruler.

19:27-30 – The disciples' deception of having left everything to follow Jesus: they're thinking rewards, not the cost.
