Matthew 22

22:1-14 – The parable of the *wedding feast*.

Point: God invites many, but many are <u>unwilling</u>.

Those sent out to invite guests refers to the prophets.

Refers to rejection by Israel and an invite to the Gentiles.

No one gets in unless properly "clothed."

22:15-22 - Rendering "to Caesar": a lesson in trust.

22:23-46 – Jesus is "tested" by the religious leaders:

23-33: ...by the Sadducees about the resurrection.

34-40: ...by the Pharisees about *the Law*.

v. 39: The most profound summary of *loving God*.

41-46: ...by the Pharisees about *David's son*.
