## Matthew 26

26:1-5 – The 4<sup>th</sup> time Jesus tells of His *crucifixion*.

26:6-13 – After foretelling His death, Jesus is *anointed*.

26:14-16 – Jesus is betrayed by Judas for 30 pieces of silver.

26:17-30 – Jesus institutes *the Last Supper*.

26:31-35 – Peter and the others deny they will *fall away*.

26:36-46 – Jesus's prayer of trust in *the Father* 

Key words: <u>"Thy will be done..."</u>

26:47-56 – Jesus is apprehended, and the disciples flee!

26:57-68 – Jesus is taken before the High Priest.

26:69-75 – In spite of his good intentions, Peter *denies Jesus*.

The key to understanding this: Peter followed Jesus "at a distance." (v. 58)
