Matthew 4

4:1-11 – The temptation of Jesus by *Satan himself*.

Note: Jesus was "<u>led by the Spirit."</u>

#1: "If You are the Son of God, "... work a miracle."

(Greek 3rd class condition, implying, "and you are...."

The temptation to use His power for His own needs.

#2: If You are the Son of God, "...<u>overcome nature."</u>
The temptation to use His power in <u>a worldly way.</u>

#3: "If You fall down and "... worship me."

The temptation to give glory to Satan rather than to God.

4:12-17 – Jesus begins His ministry by preaching repentance.

4:18-20 – Jesus begins calling His *disciples*.

Peter & Andrew, James and John.

4:21-25 – Jesus begins to <u>expand His ministry</u>. (First use of the word <u>"gospel.")</u>
