## Matthew 9

9:1-8 The healing of a paralytic based on "their faith."

Jesus points to the man's core problem: personal sin.

The point: <u>sin paralyses</u>.

Jesus declares Himself <u>"the Son of Man."</u>

Therefore, He has the power to forgive sins.

Jesus *proves* He has the power to forgive sin: "Walk!"

9:9-13 – The call of Matthew by His simple words: <u>"Follow Me."</u>

Matthew's dinner demonstrates that Jesus has compassion on all people, including <u>you and me!</u>

9:14-17 – Jesus declares that religious practices such as fasting are not the answer to being right with God. Being right with God lies in being in a close relationship *with Jesus*.

9:18-34 — Four healings with a point:

The synagogue official's daughter: she was dead!

The woman with a hemorrhage: she was unclean!

The blind men were healed: a result of their faith!

The mute, demonized man was able to praise God!

9:35-38 – Jesus was "going," "teaching," "proclaiming," and "<a href="healing">healing</a> every kind of disease and sickness."

All of Jesus's healings were based on love and compassion.

In commissioning His disciples, He is foreshadowing the <u>spread of the gospel (forgiveness of sins).</u>
