The church enjoys vibrant worship in a family atmosphere and we invite all to join us in exploring what the Bible has to say to us today.

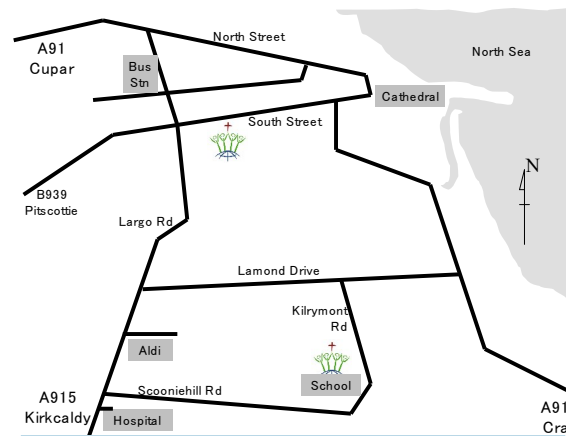
