5 x 5 x 5 New Testament Reading Plan

Read through the New Testament in 5 minutes a day, 5 days a week.

If you're not used to reading the Bible daily, start with this easy to use 5 minutes a day plan. This reading plan will take you through all 260 chapters of the New Testament one chapter per day.

Determine a time and location to spend 5 minutes a day for 5 days a week. Pause in your reading to dig in to the Bible. Here are 5 different ways to dig deeper each day:

- Underline or highlight key words or phrases in the Bible passage.
- Read the passage or verse slowly, then rewrite each phrase or sentence using your own words.
- Ask and answer questions. Ask questions about the passage using these words: who, what, when, where, why, how.
- Capture the big idea. Ask: What's the big idea in this sentence?
- Personalize the meaning. Respond as God speaks to you through the Scripture.

To keep track of your Bible reading, a Discipleship Journal for the 5 x 5 x 5 reading plan copies are available at the Welcome Center today.
