Psalm 107:1

God cares for us.

After reading the Bible passages, discuss these questions together:

How do you use water each day?

What is your favorite thing to do with water?

Where do you get water to drink? (faucet)

How does God care for you? (God created a world with streams, lakes, and oceans.)

Why did God stop the rain? (People were not listening to Him.)

Who did God send to tell the king there would be no rain? (Elijah)

Who sent the birds to care for Elijah? (God) **How does God care for us?**

Daniel in the Lions Den

Daniel 6:1-23, 25, 26

We can pray to God.

After reading the Bible passages, discuss these questions together:

What is your favorite big animal?

What do you know about lions?

I'm going to say some sentences. If the sentence is true, clap your hands. If it isn't true, shake your heads.

Daniel did lots of bad things. (shake head)

Daniel was eaten by the lions. (shake head)

God sent an angel to shut the mouths of the lions. (clap)

These questions can easily extend into the rest of the week.

Look for opportunities to bring conversations into your everyday life as a family.
