If you already have a Vanco account, you can access your account by clicking Log In at the top right corner. If you do not have a Vanco account, click on Sign Up at the top right corner. Creating an account is very quick and easy and allows you to see your past transactions as well as upcoming transactions if you set up a recurring gift.

To give towards our current campaign, you will click on the 2026 Entrusted to Act Pledge tile in the top left of the page and follow the prompts to set up your gift. You will have the option to pay with a credit/debit card or with your bank account information. Other ways to give:

Recurring payments from your checking account: This is a popular way that gives you control over your information. Contact your bank and ask them how you set up an automatic payment from your checking account. Many of you already pay your bills in this manner. The great thing about this process is that there are no credit card fees involved!

Personal Checks and Cash: Some of us just like to write a check or give cash. You can give us a check or cash on Sunday during worship, send it in the mail, or drop it by the church office Mon – Thu from 9 AM – 4 PM. If you do give cash on Sunday morning, be sure and fill out an envelope with your name and address.
