



## Lunches for Room In The Inn Guests

Lunch bags will be provided

**When:** Please bring Wednesday night

**Where:** Leave in FPC kitchen

**What:**

- **2 decaffeinated drinks:** no water (bottles not allowed in building): soda, fruit juice, Gatorade
- **2 sandwiches:**
  - 1 meat sandwich (turkey, ham, roast beef, chicken, or chicken salad)
  - 1 sandwich that will stay fresh at room temperature (cheese, peanut butter, tuna kits are especially liked by ladies)

*Bagels are very hard for some guest to eat*
- **1 or both fruit and/or vegetable:**
  - Carrot or celery sticks (thin strips please), cucumbers, oranges, tangerines, pears, bananas, fruit cups, applesauce, fruit snacks, dried fruit, raisins

*Whole apples are not recommended due to oral health issues*
- **1 or more snacks:**
  - Chips, pretzels, assorted (100 calorie snack packs), cheese & crackers, nuts, trail mix
- **Dessert:**
  - Homemade or Individually wrapped (think Little Debbie)

### **WNL RITI COORDINATORS**

One Wednesday night a month (5:45 pm - 8:00 pm)

**Who:**

- friendly, outgoing person. No other skills needed training will be provided

**When:**

- One Wednesday night a month. Arrive by 5:45 pm to greet the guests and depart when the Innkeepers feel settled (approximately 8 pm)

**What:**

- You are the on-site coordinator for the evening. You make yourself available to answer questions for the guests and for the congregation regarding RITI at FPC. Typically, this might involve giving directions, helping them find videos and start the TVs in the room, or distributing over-the-counter medicines.

**What:**

### **Breakfast for Room In The Inn**

12 guests + 2 Inn Keepers + Driver = 15 breakfasts

**When:** two options

**Option 1:** Bring food Wednesday night with instructions to serve in the morning. Be sure to label food RITI

**Option 2:** Arrive at the church @ 5 am & serve by 5:30 am

**What:**

- **Drinks:** 1 gallon of orange juice or individual servings (no milk- coffee provided)
- **Hot prepared food:** Sausage/ham and/or egg biscuit (2 each if small), breakfast casserole/quiche, bacon/ham slices w/toast or biscuits and jelly, hard boiled eggs w/toast or biscuits
- **Cold prepared & convenience food:** Breakfast bars, oatmeal, muffins, doughnuts  
*Bagels are hard for a lot of guests to eat. Yogurt, as a rule, is not eaten*
- **Fruits:** Bananas, mixed fresh fruit, individual canned fruits/applesauce, grapes  
*No whole apples*
- **Optional Items:** Chocolate milk, cheese sticks/cubes/slices, be creative

## SET UP PROCEDURES

**Please arrive no later than 5 pm to set up**

### SET OUT THE RITI BUY DINNER FOR A GUEST "FRAME" ON THE MONEY BASKET TABLE

#### ROOM SET UP:

- Set up 12 beds in rooms 206 ( 4 beds), 207 (4 beds), & 208 (4 beds) for 12 guests. Room 209 & 210 are for church members spending the night (aka InnKeepers)
- Linens are in clear bag in the RITI closet across from the kitchen. Extra linens are on the shelf
- Pillows & mattresses are stored in the closet (beside the dessert table) in Wilson Hall. Beds need a fitted & top sheet. Guest will bring a blanket.
- Arrange room to give each guest some personal space. Place a chair by each bed for guest items. Place a mint/candy (stored above small sink in fellowship hall) on each pillow.
- *Note: Do not lay towels out in the rooms, they will be offered later in the evening.*

#### BATHROOM SET UP:

- All supplies are in the RITI closet in the hallway by the kitchen
- Two showers are located in the hallway by the music rooms
- Check to see that there is soap & shampoo in the shower
- Place bath mat in front of showers. Move shelf out of the shower.
- Used towels go in a large black garbage bag that should be placed outside the bathroom door
- *Note: guests are given a form to request supplies- no extra ones in the rooms, please*

### **RIDE ALONG**

**Please arrive no later than 4:15**

#### **What:**

- Drive down to the Room In the Inn Campus to pick up guests.
- Once guests are settled on the bus, distribute and help guests complete request form
- Share procedural information with guests prior to their arrival at the church (script is provided)
- Help guests into the building and give request forms to RITI coordinator

#### **When :**

- Depart FPC no later than 4:15 pm on Wednesday evening and return around 6 pm

### **BUS DRIVER**

**Wednesday nights and Thursday mornings**

#### **When:** 2 options

1. Wednesday evenings depart FPC no later than 4:15 pm and return around 6 pm
2. Thursday mornings depart FPC no later than 6am and return around 7:30 am

#### **Who:**

- Anyone 25 or older
- New this year- no CDL required

**Who:**

- 2 individuals ( you and a friend, you and your spouse, you and an experienced innkeeper)

**When:**

- Arrive by 6:30 pm on Wednesday evening (WNL dinner at 6 pm) and depart shortly after 6 am on Thursday morning.

**What:**

- You will be the onsite FPC representative for the evening. Bring your sleeping bag and use our air mattress to sleep on. You and the other Innkeeper are there as host to the guests. In the morning, you will wake up around 4:45 to get breakfast warmed and served. Guests depart at 6 am. WE WILL HAPPILY SET YOU UP WITH AN EXPERIENCED INN KEEPER! You will never be put into a situation which you do not feel supported. This is a wonderful opportunity to directly impact the lives of others.
