Every week, 80 to 100 meals are delivered to individuals and families who are not able to shop and prepare meals for themselves. This incredible work is done by a small group of dedicated people over two days: shopping, cooking, prepping and delivering - but they aren't just dropping off meals, they visit and spend time and pray with the recipients. In addition to sharing God's love to others, the members of this group also minister to each other with unending love and support. Serving opportunities: Tuesday Night in the CovP Kitchen, Wednesday Deliveries and Visits, Sunday drives to church, handyman needs and chores or anytime visits. Whether you like to cook, clean or counsel, get ready to be blessed and transformed.

CANA

Originally founded as a mid-life married couples' group, Cana celebrates Jesus' first miracle with monthly in-home dinner fellowship. Rotating amongst its members, we break bread and then share in hosted scriptural devotion and prayer for our group and its loved ones. New couples are always welcome! As a community, we rejoice in the knowledge that as time goes on and some of us leave to go home with the Lord, Cana will continue to support those spouses left behind with our ongoing fellowship.

COMMUNITY BIBLE STUDY – WEDNESDAY MORNING

On occasion there are video topics by renowned theologians such as R.C. Sproul. A healthy discussion with Q&A follows. There is always something to be learned! Class is held during Foundation Hour: Sundays at 9am in Heritage Lounge.
