

# MAJOR ANNOUNCEMENTS

Dear Friend,

As a members of the international community, country, state, and the Wesleyan Village, we are under a threat from the COVID-19. In recent days, I have observed that many residents do not observe good distancing between individuals. In light of what is happening in our state and the Governor's request, not a directive, for 65+ citizens to "SHELTER IN PLACE," here are new procedures for our Wesleyan Village:

1. Since the general population of Wesleyan Village is the most vulnerable age group for COVID-19, we are following Florida Governor Ron DeSantis's lead by attempting to reduce contact points within our village. We need to take seriously the instructions to maintain a healthy and safe distance between individuals. The distance between you and your spouse is up to you.
2. **Effective immediately**, resident village residents are urged to "SHELTER IN PLACE" and *only* venture from their homes to conduct necessary business such as food, gas, doctors, pick up prescriptions, and work if applicable. To that end, the following actions are being implemented:
  - A. **Effective Immediately**, the Elliott Center is closed for all activities except for the delivery and pick-up of mail.
  - B. The usage of the Village laundry rooms should be limited to one person at a time.
  - C. The usage of the Dog Park is limited to one family at a time.
  - D. The Wesleyan Village office will maintain its regular hours. However, the front doors will be locked and only two persons will be allowed into the office at one time. Some staff members will be working from their homes.
  - E. The bread delivery may be picked up in the Dining Room beginning this Saturday morning (April 4, 2020) from 9:15-9:45 a.m. The Dining Room Staff will organize the bread for distribution.

Friends, this announcement is to help our community for our future till this pandemic has passed. When we come out on the other side, we as individuals and as a community want to be able to say, "TO GOD BE THE GLORY".
