# MADE TO MAGNIFY



## 5 Day Devotional - Watch: Made To Magnify Day 1: Recognizing God's Holiness

#### **Devotional**

Worship is not something that we manufacture. It is something that we magnify. When we see God as He truly is, worship should be a natural outflow in our life. Isaiah 6:1-4 paints a vivid picture of God's holiness. Isaiah saw the Lord high and exalted, and the train of His robe filled the temple. The seraphim called out, 'Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of His glory.' This vision of God's holiness caused Isaiah to recognize his own unworthiness and confess his sins. True worship begins with recognizing who God truly is—His holiness, purity, and majesty. When we see God in His true light, our natural response is awe and reverence.

#### **Bible Verse**

'In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple.' - Isaiah 6:1

#### **Reflection Ouestion**

How does recognizing God's holiness change the way you approach worship?

#### Prayer

Lord, help me to see You as You truly are—holy and exalted. Let my worship be a natural response to Your greatness. Amen.

### **Day 2: Responding with Surrender**

#### Devotional

Worship is recognizing who God truly is and responding with total surrender. When Isaiah saw God, he didn't simply admire Him; he fell apart and confessed his sins. This act of surrender is crucial in worship. Psalm 95 invites us to come before God with thanksgiving and joyful songs, recognizing Him as our Creator and King. #### **Bible Verse**

'Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker.' - Psalm 95:6

#### **Reflection Question**

What areas of your life do you need to surrender to God in worship?

#### **Prayer**

Lord, I surrender my life to You. Help me to worship You with my whole heart and to live in obedience to Your will. Amen.

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## Day 3: Finding Rest in God

#### Devotional

#### Bible Verse
