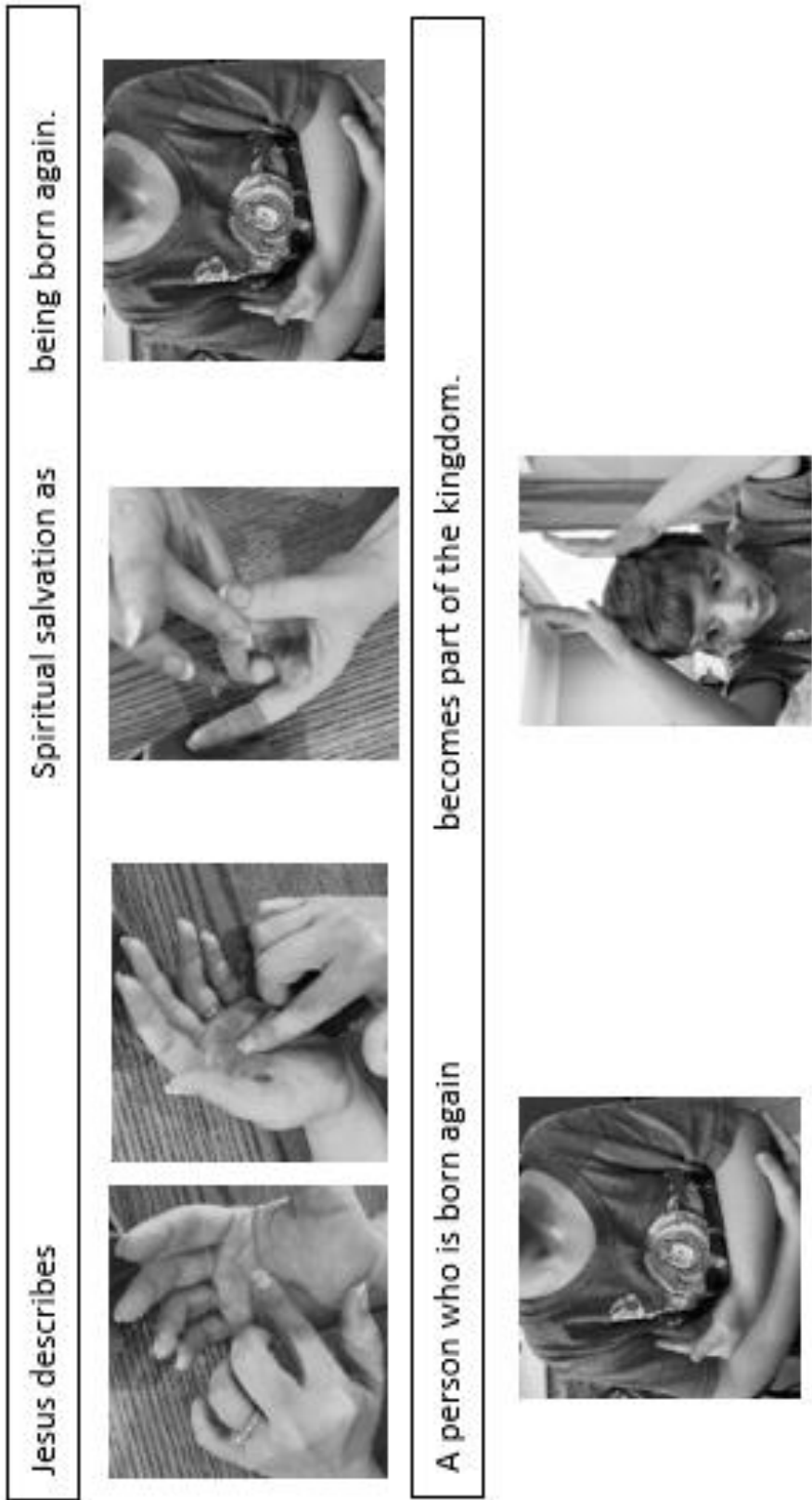

- When Jesus started traveling around teaching and healing people, what region did he travel in? (Matt.4:23)

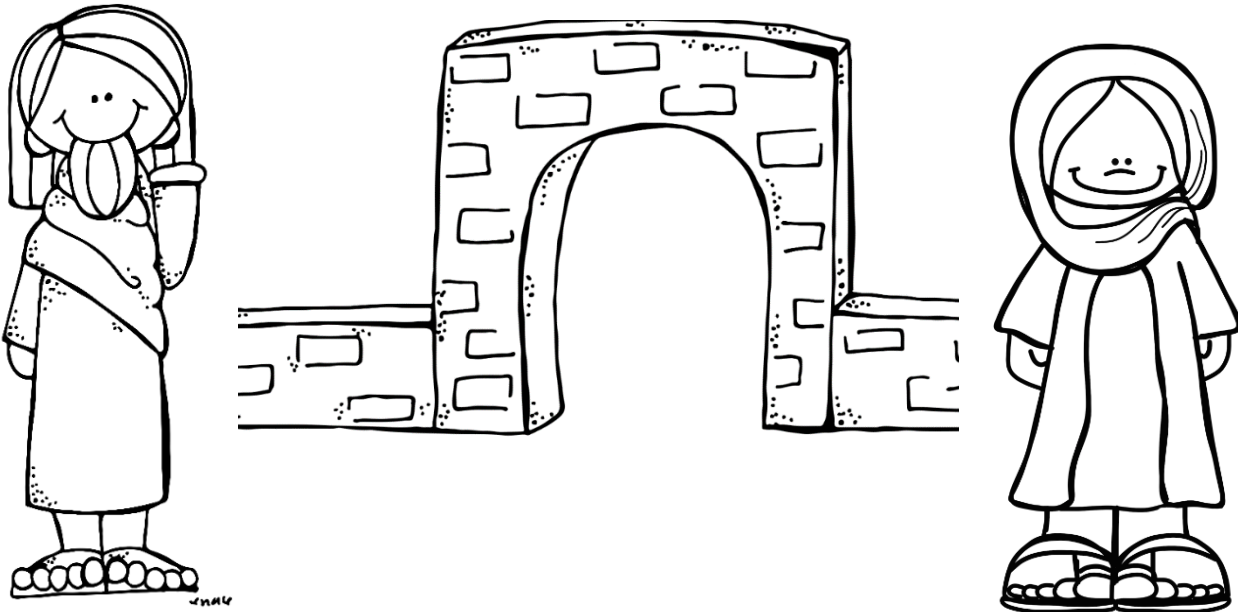

- What time of day did the official's son begin to get better? (John 4:52)

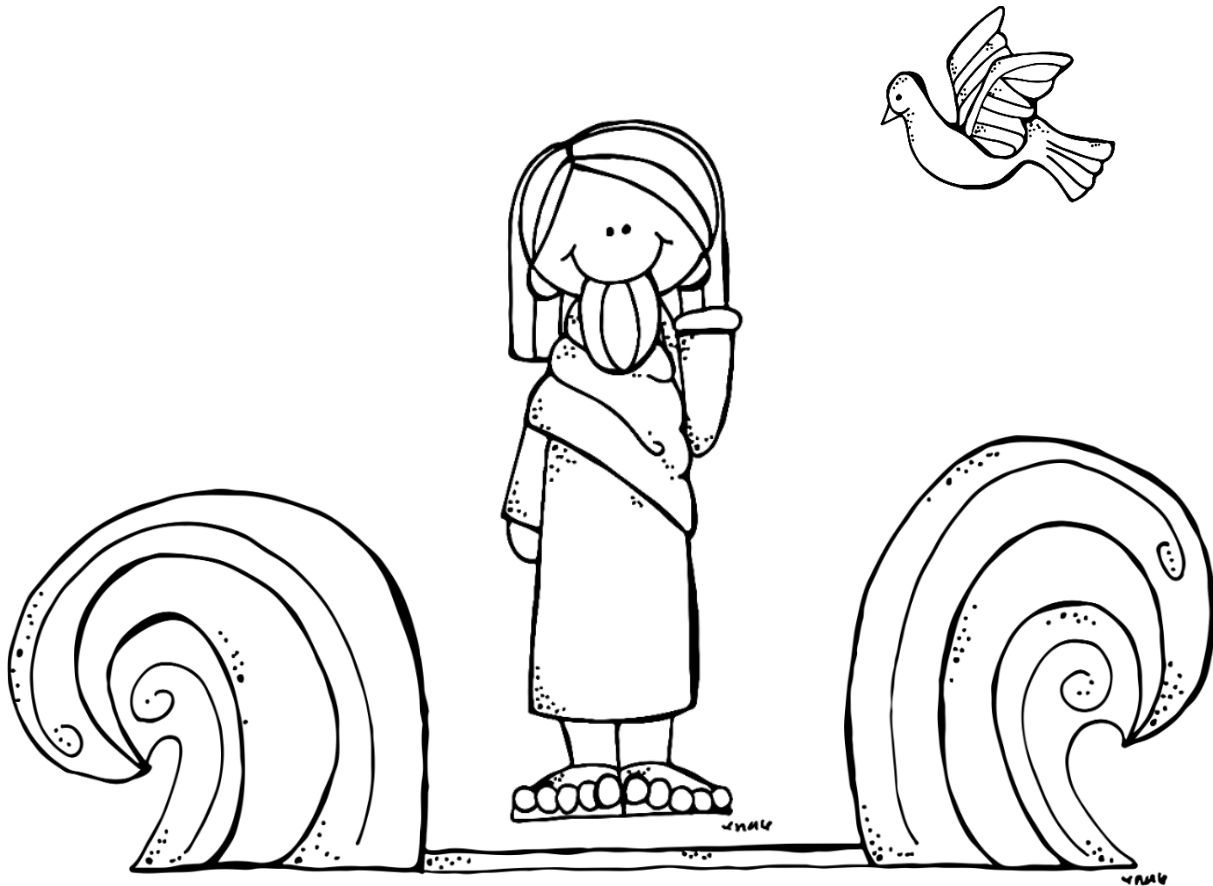
