

Oak Hill Cemetery

Summary Sheet for Prospective Cemetery Patrons

The cemetery is located approximately 1.5 miles past I-95 on the right side of Highway 17. It is just behind the Baptist cemetery. A map of the cemetery layout is shown on the RHUMC website under cemetery ministry.

An application must be submitted and approved.

There are three sections of plots on each side of the road.

Bronze Markers

Headstones or slabs or bronze markers

Headstones and/or slabs

Bronze markers must measure at least 8 by 10 inches with minimum $\frac{1}{4}$ inch thickness.

Headstones will not exceed four feet in height.

Grave sites are 5 feet by 10 feet.

Husband generally is buried on the left, wife on the right.

No benches are allowed.

Floral arrangements and miscellaneous objects must be removed within one week after burial.

Cemetery plots cost \$800 for members of RHUMC and \$1000 for non-members. There is no partial payment plan.

After review of the website and visitation to the cemetery any patron interested in purchasing a plot may contact the church secretary who will make arrangements for one of the cemetery committee members to call them.

The opening and closing of the Niche Wall vaults shall be the responsibility of the Richmond Hill Funeral Home and the engraving shall be done by Bailey Monumental and match existing lettering.
