- **Behavior Expectations for Students**

- **3 STRIKE SYSTEM**

- **TOP BEHAVIORS WE WILL ADDRESS** (Not all but main ones)

- 1. Not being with the group
      - 2. Causing physical or verbal harm
      - 3. Excessive Defiant Behavior

- **1st STRIKE:** Depending on the severity, the student will receive their 1st warning and parents will receive a copy of the report.

- **2nd STRIKE:** If behavioral issues happen again, we will fill out an incident report and call a parent/guardian to help resolve the issue. This will be their second warning.

- **3rd STRIKE:** If behaviors continue a third time, we will have the students take a break from youth (length of the break is at the discretion of the youth director). If a trip/youth event happens during that time frame the student is also banned from that event.

- After the appointed break time is over the student may return to youth. As mentioned, we will always seek to redirect and help students correct behaviors with our behavior management strategies and encouraging of loving God, others, and self. This policy is in place to help us with more challenging situations.

- **INTRODUCE SMALL GROUP LEADERS**

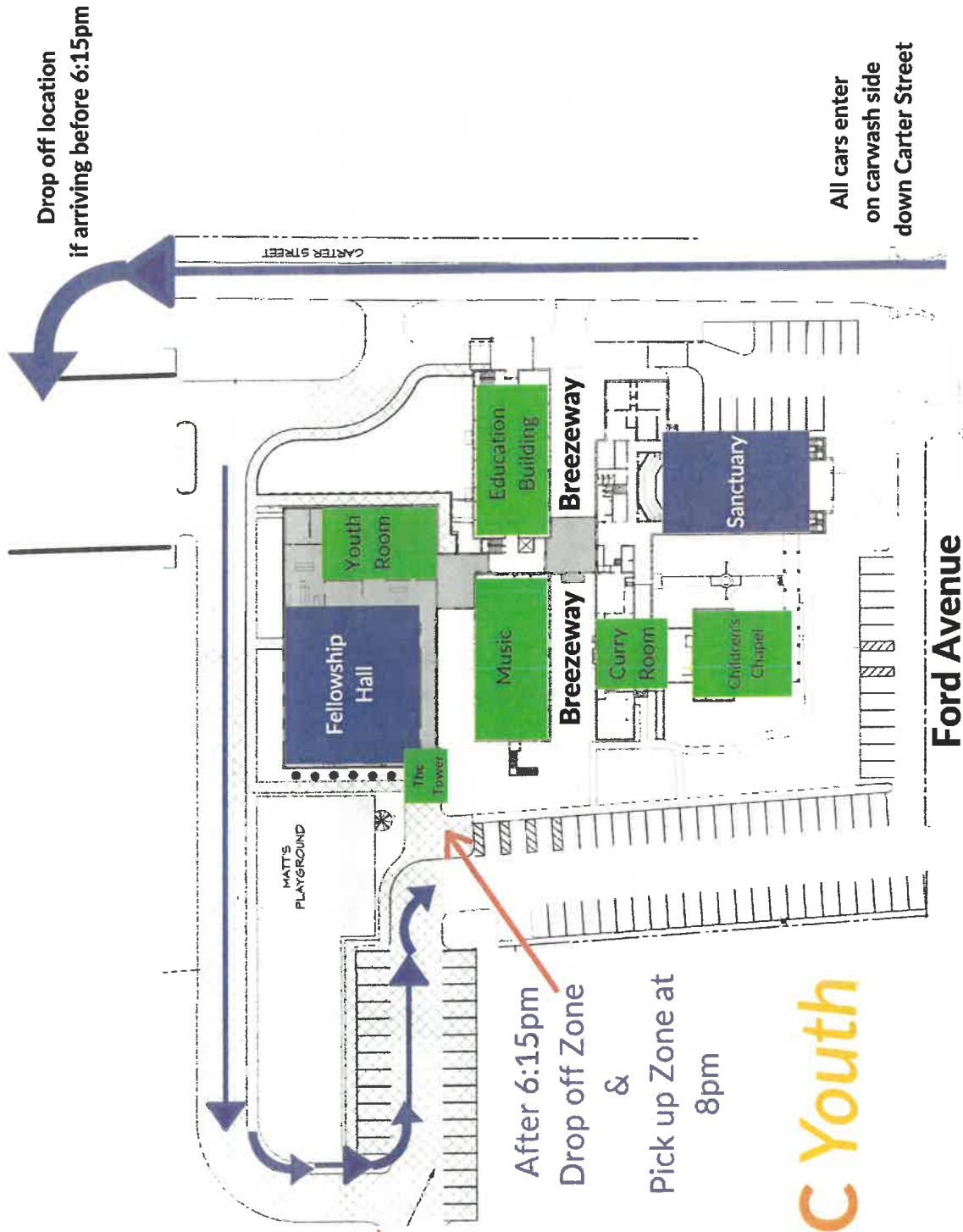
- I save the best for last

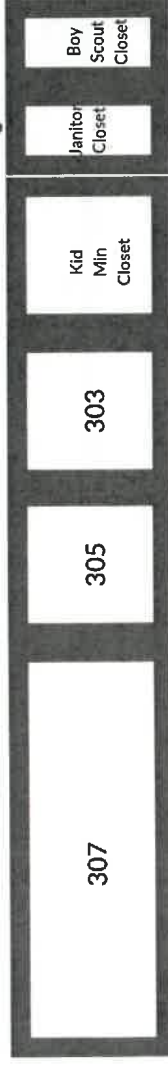
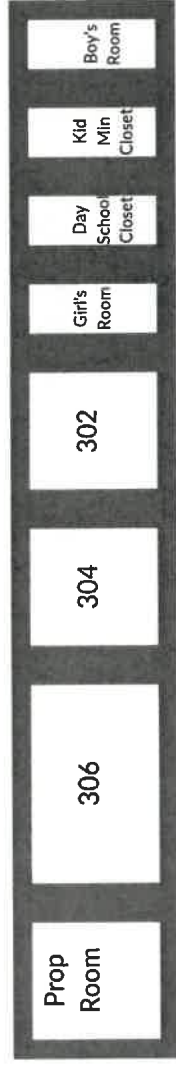

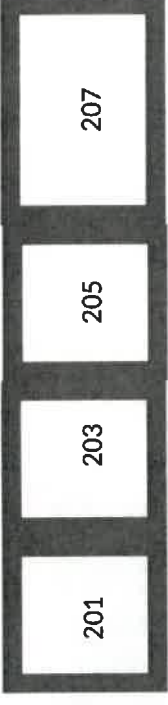
## 300 Wing Up Extra Stairs

### **TRIPS AND EVENTS**

#### **March 2024 ONE Conference (3/8-3/9)**

- This event will be held at local churches and JF Gregory in Richmond Hill
- Cost \$50 (includes everything needed)
- We will need chaperones
- More info coming soon

#### **MAY 2024 Snowbird 2024 - 7th Graders and Up (5/27-6/1)**

- Cost of the trip is **\$620 (current estimation)** - includes lodging and meals (except on the way up and back). SWO is currently not equipped to provide special dietary menus choices for gluten or other allergies.
- **9/13 - \$100 deposit due** (non-refundable) We are not able to give Snowbird your name for registration if your deposit is not received by this date (9/13). You can also make partial payments as long as the full deposit is paid in full by 9/13.
- **DO NOT PAY SWO DIRECTLY. PAYMENTS ARE MADE TO RHUMC.**
- **January 24** - Last day to back out without owing the remaining balance in full.
- **April 17** - full remaining balance due by 5:00pm
- **NEW SWO REQUIREMENTS**
  - Must attend 3 RHUMC events (not counting all small group nights)
  - Must have attended and signed in on kiosk during at least 1 RHUMC event.
  - Sign up will be a first come first serve and will have a hard cap (120 students & 14 adults). All others will go to the waiting list in sign up order.
  - Current 7th grade students and up may go on this trip.

#### **JUN 2024 Camp Connect - Rising 6th Graders-8th Graders (6/17-6/21))**

- Cost of trip is **\$425 (current estimation)**- Includes lodging and meals (except on the way up and back). Epworth by the Sea is able to meet gluten/nut free requirements upon request.
- **1/17 - \$100 deposit due** (non-refundable) We are not able to give Camp Connect your name for registration if your deposit is not received by this date (1/17). You can also make partial payments as long as the full deposit is paid in full by 1/17.
- **4/10** - full remaining balance due by 5:00pm
