Student Ministries Internship

JOB DESCRIPTION:

Student Ministries Interns receive direct line management from the Director and Assistant Director of Student Ministries with the goal of developing and maintaining Trinity Student Ministries Summer program. They work with both Jr and Sr High students. This is a paid internship, further details of compensation are available on application.

RESPONSIBILITIES/EXPECTATIONS:

- Continue with an active and growing relationship with Jesus
- Attend weekly staff planning meetings including occasional leading of staff devotions
- Maintain consistent office hours (14+ per week)
- Attend all youth group functions (8-10+ hours per week) as follows:
- Teaching: Contribute to the development of Summer Teaching Series as well as practice teaching during Sunday morning (Jr High), Tuesday night (Sr High), and Wednesday night (Jr High).
- Relationships
 - Leading small groups
 - Regular relational time with students in groups (off-campus hangouts, etc, 3-5+ hours per week)
 - Enable new/disconnected people to find their place in the group
- Events
 - Plan and implement Middle School Summer Retreat
 - Plan and implement weekly Wednesday Junior High Hang-outs
 - Participate in Detroit Mission Trip (August 8-11)
 - Plan and deliver two summer special events for Senior High
- Admin
 - Send Weekly Emails
 - Update Social Media
 - Create Flyers/Postcards
 - Create Keynotes
 - Budget work (Filing and submission of receipts, etc.)

TRAINING/GOALS:

- Intern will learn/improve teaching & prep strategies
- Intern will read and respond to one book over the duration of the season
- Intern will be taught the steps required to turn an idea into reality, by seeing it through to the end (leading to intern's autonomy in ability to produce an entire event)
