Ice Breaker

If you could only have one meal for the rest of your life, what would it be?

1. What struck you most about the message? Why?
2. What does Jesus mean when He says “do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures to eternal life”? (John 6:
3. John tells us that there was a boy who had five loaves and two fishes (6:9). This was obviously not enough to feed everyone and Jesus uses this to teach us a lesson. What do you perceive in your life as

“not enough” or “not good enough” that Jesus may very well want to use? Share boldly and encourage one another that God can use any gift, small or large!

4. Tye mentioned Sunday that Jesus demonstrates that He is indeed Deity, equal with God. Omnipotent (all powerful), omnipresent (all present), and omniscience (all knowing). Find one other instance where Jesus demonstrates these three. (Hint: If you are still confused about each mean, do a Google search.)
5. What was one thing in the message this week that strengthened your faith?
