2. What is the significance that the Word (Jesus) was in the beginning with God?
3. What are some reasons people reject Jesus?
4. Jesus was full of grace and truth. Why is this important? (Hint: start by defining grace and truth.)

Extra credit: Read John 1:19-34. Discuss the ministry of John Baptist. Key in on his statement, "Behold the Lamb of God" in verse 29.
