"Fear and anxiety express our fragility more than our sin. The world is a scary place, and we are finite and weak people."

Our longing for trouble-free life in a troubled world echoes Eden before weeds intruded on our work and worry invaded our relationships. Today, tomorrow is a problem. Anxiety is our reality; we live in an inescapable anxious world. In pastoral counseling, there is surprising relief in normalizing anxiety, recognizing anxiety is fear of loss in a world of loss. Through His ministry and message, the Son of God never denies or dismisses our worries. Instead, He reminds us that what anxiety wants more than an answer is a Person. Offering clarity and comfort, God's Word does not shame the anxious for lacking faith but instead invites the fearful to experience the nearness of a Heavenly Father.

Clarity. Biblically framed, anxiety is not a barrier to our faith but a doorway to deeper

faith. Anxiety helps identify what we love and what we fear losing. To love is to experience anxiety; we cannot eliminate anxiety unless we eliminate love. For believers living in a fallen world, anxiety is the opportunity to deepen our trust in the love of a Heavenly Father. As part of the team at Link Care, the role of therapy and medication for specific anxiety disorders are divine gifts in cultivating awareness and the ability to respond to God's nearness. As a pastoral counselor, walking alongside fellow strugglers, the journey is rediscovering that we have a Person, a Father in Heaven intimately fathering us on earth to unburden us from the "weight of the world" we cannot bear. To bear this weight, Jesus willingly entered our troubled world? for us to be with us. He came to embrace the worst of anxiety on the Cross to become the client and counselor's eternal hope and daily help.

Comfort. For today, in the counseling room, Jesus' ongoing ministry is the assurance of our Father's constant, attentive, and inescapable presence, knowing our fears even before we do! He bottles our tears and hears our cries; he is near, listening for us to speak to Him, to prove He is our safe place (Phil. 4:5; Ps. 56:8-9; 62:8). When Jesus taught, "Fear not, little flock, it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom," He legitimized fear in a dangerous world but not without assuring us that the Father has a special affection for us and is up to something good through our anxieties (Lk. 12). Our Father sacrificed His Son to secure the coming redeemed earth that is trouble-free, without fear, anxiety, and worries. Until then, we have a Person, the right Person. Who does not shame us for our fears but lavishes us with grace and mercy instead. Jesus promises to care for and about our tomorrows and repeatedly promises that we can never be alone in the troubles of today (Ps. 23, 46; John 14; Rom. 8; Heb 13).
