

About the Artist:

Dr. Mark Baumann

Dr. Mark Baumann, CAGO, first started studying the organ with Ruth Halterman, a student of Harry Christiansen who was the organist at First Lutheran Church from 1947-1984. His studies have included organ performance, music education and hymnology. Mark received a B.A. at Central College in Pella studying with Davis Folkerts and then an M.A. and Ph. D. at The University of Iowa, studying with Delores Bruch and Delbert Disselhorst. Mark also holds the distinction of Colleague awarded by the American Guild of Organists.



Mark has served churches in Marion, Decorah, Iowa City and Cedar Rapids. From 1993-2000, he was Director of Christian Education at First Lutheran Church and was a substitute at the organ for Dr. Brett Wolgast. Since 2009, he has served at St. Paul's United Methodist Church and is the Coordinator of Music Ministries, where he is the organist, directs the Men's Ensemble, partners with the pastors in worship planning, recruits and rehearses with a wide array of instrumentalists and vocalists, and leads youth music. Mark also teaches organ and piano for the Orchestra Iowa School, operates a private music studio, and is the college organist at Cornell College in Mt. Vernon. He does a variety of workshops, leads hymn festivals, and does composition. Mark and his wife Marcia reside in Marion with their three basset hounds. They have three grown daughters, and five grandchildren.
