Can it be that Thanksgiving is only a few weeks away? We all know what that means: Christmas and 2020 are not far behind!





WORDS OF PRAISE AND THANKS!

OLD TESTAMENT:

"YADAH": To throw or cast; to give thanks; to laud or praise; to confess something about God; to confess one's own sin. Used: 114 times in OT, in the following ways: praise (53x), give thanks (32x), confess (16x), thank (5x), make confession (2x), thanksgiving (2x), cast (1x), cast out (1x), shoot (1x), thankful (1x).

Example: 1 Chronicles 16:8

"TODAH": Confession, praise, thanksgiving; giving of praise to God; thanksgiving in songs of worship; thanksgiving choir or procession; thank-offering; sacrifice of thanksgiving. <u>Used</u>: 32x in OT, in the following ways: thanksgiving (18x), praise (6x),

thanks (3x), thank offerings (3x), confession (2x). Example: 2 Chronicles 29:31

"Y'DAH": To praise; give thanks. Used: 2 x in OT (Dan. 2:23, 6:10)

"HALLEL" [think, "Hallelujah"]: To shine; make shine; to give forth a clear and distinct sound. Example: Psalm 35:18

NEW TESTAMENT:

"DOXA", "DOXADZO" [think, "Doxology"]: Glory; to glorify (over 200x).

Example: John 9:24

"EULOGEO" [think, "Eulogy"]: To speak well of (16x). Example: Luke 1:64

"AYPANOS": To praise (11x). Example: Luke 2:13

"EUCHARISTIA" [think, "Eucharist"]: Thanks (over 50x in noun and verb form).


Example: Ephesians 5:4



"OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD!"

We are blessed to be involved again this year - as we have been for a number of years! - with "Operation Christmas Child", a ministry of Samaritan's Purse (www.samaritanspurse.org). Since 1993, the Samaritan's Purse has collected and delivered more than 100 million gift-filled shoeboxes to children in more than 100 countries. Celebrating its 26th anniversary, Operation Christmas Child expects to collect another 10 million shoebox gifts in 2019.

Individuals, families and groups fill empty shoeboxes with gifts of toys, school supplies, hygiene items and notes of encouragement. During National Collection Week, Nov. 18-25, 2019, Samaritan's Purse will collect the gift-filled shoeboxes at more than 3,500 drop-off sites in all 50 states and Puerto Rico. Grace Bible Church is one of those drop-off sites. At the processing centers (see below), a Gospel pamphlet, in the language of the child who will receive the shoebox, is placed in each box.

After the boxes are prepared for overseas shipment at eight major processing centers across the United States - Atlanta; Boone, N.C.; Charlotte; Dallas; Denver; Honolulu; Minneapolis; and Orange County, Calif. - Samaritan's Purse and its partners will deliver the gifts to children in more than 100 countries on six continents.

<u>NOTE</u>: Donors (<u>\$9</u> per shoebox) can find out the country where their shoebox gifts are delivered by using the donation form found at <u>samaritanspurse.org</u>. Click on "Support" and "Follow Your Box". Please follow instructions carefully.

Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes are collected in the United States, Australia, Austria, Canada, Finland, Germany, Ireland, Japan, New Zealand, Spain, Switzerland and the United Kingdom.

More than 500,000 volunteers worldwide, with over 100,000 of those in the United States, are involved in collecting, shipping and distributing shoebox gifts.

So, Grace Bible sisters and brothers in Christ, let's get involved! Empty shoeboxes can be found in the foyer of our church. Please read the instructions prior to packing a shoebox. "Completed" shoeboxes are due at the church no later than Sunday, November 24, Noon. Last year, folks from our church packed 155 shoeboxes full of goodies for children around the world. Our goal this year is 250 boxes! We in America have so much... the children of the world have so little. Let's help them have a little nicer Christmas. Let's help them hear about Jesus Christ!

The Book of the Revelation

Chapter 21 - Part 1

The New Heavens and the New Earth

After the 1,000 - year reign, and after the Great White Throne Judgment, God starts anew with new heavens and a new earth. John writes in verses 1–7, "Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also, there was no more sea. Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away." Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Witte, for these words are true and faithful." And He said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts. He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son." But in verse 8, God issues a warning, "But, the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone [the Lake of Fire], which is the second death." Then John is shown the New Jerusalem. In verses 9 – 11a, John writes, "Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, "Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife." And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, having the glory of God." This will be our new home with Jesus in His Kingdom; it will be a wonderful time in a wonderful place! Next month, we will take a closer look at the New Jerusalem.

Prophecy Update

Just a reminder that the focal point for the Rapture, Prophecy, and the End Times are based upon the events in Israel and the Middle East. The Middle east is now in great turmoil! Russia, Turkey, Iran, Iraq, and the Kurds are all vying to claim a part of Syria to occupy. Plus, there is the conflict between the Sunni Muslims and the Shilte Muslims. So far Israel has been able to stay out of the conflict. Also, Saudi Arabia attacked an Iranian oil tanker with missiles as retaliation for their attack on the Saudi's oil refinery.

Besides the turmoil in the Middle East, many other places in the world are in turmoil. The Democrats in the U.S. continue to try to find some way to impeach President Trump. Israel has not yet chosen a Prime Minister; Netanyahu has until the end of October to put a coalition Government together. Britain is still trying to get out of the European Union. And other problems now going on in Venezuela, France, Spain, and as well as other countries.

The world is looking for answers to its problems, and is ready for the Antichrist to come and "fix" everything. It appears as if the Rapture of Jesus' Church is drawing closer and closer. Remember that the Rapture of Jesus' Church is imminent and will come at any time, in "the twinkling of an eye".

With all of this that is going on, I encourage you to accept Jesus as your Lord and Savior while there is still time; the time is growing short. Just call on/to Him, and follow Him; come to Him just as you are, now, you don't have to make yourself "acceptable". And then, be a witness of salvation through Jesus Christ to your unsaved family and friends, relatives, neighbors, and co-workers. Remember that we are not good enough in and of ourselves to do enough good "works" or "deeds" to get into Heaven. And neither can our church, nor our "priest" or "bishop", nor our "family", nor our religion, nor our possessions save us. Please do not let your "pride" stand in the way of, or procrastinate, your decision to accept Jesus as your Lord and Savior! Remember what Jesus said in The Gospel of John, chapter 14, verse 6, "Jesus said to him [that is to the Apostle Thomas], 'I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life. No one comes to the Father [into His Kingdom in heaven] except through Me."

And we as Christians should NOT "cling" to the things of this world, as we are going to leave all of them behind; even, unfortunately, our unsaved loved ones.

There is a wonderful Kingdom of Heaven, to be gained; Heaven is going to be a new life with Jesus Christ! But there is also the Tribulation and Hell (the Lake of Fire) to avoid at all costs!! The Tribulation is going to be a horrific time (much worse than anybody expects!); with the return of the Nephilim (the fallen angels), demons, and the giants, and the coming of the False Prophet, the Antichrist, and the "Dragon"!

As I said, the Rapture of Jesus' Church is imminent and will come at any time, and many signs of the Last Days are appearing all around us. Remember that your soul is eternal and will live forever!; Either with Jesus in Heaven...or in the eternal torment of Hell (the Lake of Fire!)!
