Prayer Guide

DAY 1 | UNITED IN GOD'S LOVE

"That they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You."
John 17:21

Pray that every church in our community would be rooted and grounded first in love for God — that His love would overflow into love for one another, erasing competition and birthing true partnership.

DAY 2 | HUMILITY AS OUR FOUNDATION

"Being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind." Philippians 2:2–3

Ask the Lord to replace pride and self-promotion in our churches with genuine humility. Pray that leaders and congregations would esteem others more highly than themselves and seek the good of the whole Body.

DAY 3 | BREAKING DOWN DIVIDING WALLS

"For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one and has broken down the middle wall of separation." Ephesians 2:14

Intercede for healing across racial, cultural, generational, and denominational divides. Pray for the courage to cross boundaries, confess where the Church has been complicit in division, and walk together in reconciliation.

DAY 4 | LOVE THAT BINDS US TOGETHER

"But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection." Colossians 3:14

Pray for a fresh outpouring of agape love in our congregations — love that is patient, kind, and selfless. Ask God to knit our hearts together so that the world sees and is drawn to Christ through our unity.

DAY 5 | ONE BODY, MANY MEMBERS

"For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ."
Corinthians 12:12

Lift up the unique gifts and callings of each church in our community. Pray that we would see one another not as competition but as essential members of one Body — and that we would celebrate and resource each other's strengths.

DAY 6 | PURSUING PEACE TOGETHER

"Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace."
Ephesians 4:3

Where there is offense, misunderstanding, or unresolved conflict between churches and leaders, pray for the Holy Spirit to bring conviction and a willingness to pursue peace. Ask God to make our community known as a place of genuine reconciliation.

DAY 7 | A HEART OF FORGIVENESS

"Forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you."
Ephesians 4:32

Pray for believers and church leaders who carry wounds from past church hurts, betrayals, or denominational conflicts. Ask God to release a spirit of forgiveness so that old offenses no longer hinder the advance of His Kingdom.

DAY 8 | UNITED IN MISSION

"Stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel." Philippians 1:27

Intercede for our community churches to align around a shared gospel mission. Pray for collaborative outreach efforts, shared resources, and a unified voice that declares the Good News with power and clarity to our city.

DAY 9 | BLESSING OUR COMMUNITY

"Seek the peace of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the Lord on its behalf." Jeremiah 29:7

Pray together as the Church for the needs of our city and neighborhood — the lost, the broken, the poor, and the overlooked. Ask God to release compassion and practical resources through unified churches to be the hands and feet of Jesus.

DAY 10 | REVIVAL THROUGH UNITY

"Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! ... For there the Lord commanded the blessing — life forevermore." Psalm 133:1, 3b

On this final day, cry out for a sweeping revival that flows from the unity of God's people. Pray that as we dwell together in unity, God would command His blessing — a spiritual awakening that transforms our families, streets, and city for His glory.
