Pet Squad - Week 4 — Need to Know: A Heart After God Respects Others

 **Our Bible Story for Today: *David Spares Saul's Life (1 Samuel : 18,22,24)***

Ask Your Child...

- Why did David choose not to hurt King Saul even though Saul was trying to hurt him? (He wanted to honor God. He knew Saul was still the king God chose. He trusted God's plan instead of taking revenge.)
- How did David show respect to both Saul and God? (He spared Saul's life. He spoke kindly to him. He trusted God to make him king at the right time.)
- What does it mean to trust God's timing like David did? (Not rushing ahead. Waiting patiently. Believing God will keep His promises.)
- Who is someone you can show respect to this week — even if they aren't being kind to you? (A sibling, friend, classmate, teacher, or parent.)

This week, choose one person in your home or school to intentionally show extra respect to — through your words, attitude, or actions.

🙏 Prayer Challenge:

God, help me have a heart after You by choosing respect, even when it's hard. Show me one person this week I can honor with my words and actions. Amen.
