
Week ONE: Day ONE

Help me choose what is right. Amen.


Week ONE: Day TWO

do better tomorrow. Amen.


Week ONE: Day THREE

Dear Jesus, please help me be kind and make things right with others. Give me courage to say sorry or forgive when I need to. Amen.


Week ONE: Day FOUR

than Jesus sometimes?




Dear Jesus, help me love You more than anything else.

best. Amen.


LIVING GOD'S WAY

others don't. Amen.


Week TWO: Day ONE

Do I try to get along with other believers and show love like Jesus?




Jesus, thank You for loving us so much. Help me be kind and work together with other believers. Help us be one. Amen.

Amen.


CHOOSING HARMONY

Dear God, I give my life to You. Help me follow Your ways and be who You created me to be. Amen.



Amen.


Week THREE: Day THREE

time?




Dear God, help me trust You while I wait. Thank You for

God, I put my hope in You. Help me wait patiently and trust You with my whole heart. Amen.


Week THREE: Day SEVEN
